## GENERAL INFORMATION

### ***Registration Form and Entry Fee***

The registration form and entry fee **MUST** be received by **Tuesday, September 7, 2010.**

Works must be hand delivered on Friday, September 17, 2010, from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm to the Sunset River Marketplace Gallery, 10283 Beach Drive SW, Calabash, North Carolina. Directions and map available at web site:

### ***Eligibility***

The show is open to artists 18 and older who are residents of Brunswick County or who are members of the Associated Artists of Southport, Oak Island Art Guild, Waterway Art Association, or Brunswick Arts Council.

### ***Conditions***

Entries must be original works, not previously shown at the BAC Annual Fall Exhibition. Ceramics, drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, or a combination of the listed media created in the last four years (2006 - 2010) will be considered. 2D art works must be suitably framed and securely wired ready to hang. All entries must not exceed 40" in any direction. Three dimensional work must not exceed 50 pounds. No entry that requires the artist to be present for moving or assembly will be accepted..

### ***Entry Fee***

A maximum of two art works are allowed per artist. Submit a non-refundable entry fee of \$25 for members of Brunswick Arts Council, AAS, Waterway Art Association, and Oak Island Art Guild. Fee for non-members is \$30. Make check payable to: Brunswick Arts Council. (See entry form)

### ***Sales***

Artists will receive 100% of sales price. Works may be listed as *Not For Sale*.

### ***Awards Reception***

Artists in the exhibition, members of the Brunswick Arts Council, supporting guilds and associations, and friends are invited to a reception on Sunday, September 26, 2010, from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm (award ceremony at 3:00 pm).

## JUDGES

**3D-Judge: Elizabeth Keller,**  
Professor of Art, Coastal Carolina University, South Carolina. A ceramic artist and educator, Professor Keller is nationally known for her narrative ceramic sculptures and whimsical team pots. She holds the BA, Fine Art, Furman University; BA, Anthropology, University of Massachusetts; and the MFA, Ceramics, Clemson University. Recent exhibitions include: *23rd National Contemporary Craft Exhibition*, Center for the Visual Arts, Denton Texas; *Carolina Fest 2010*, juried competition, Florence South Carolina; and *Contemporary Conversations*, Center for Contemporary Art, Columbia, South Carolina.

**2D-Judge: Donald Furst,**  
Professor of Art, University of North Carolina at Wilmington. He has been on the faculty since 1985 and was Chair of the Department of Art and Art History 2002 through 2009. Professor Furst has exhibited in 77 National and International competitive art exhibitions. He holds the BA, Studio Art; MA, Printmaking; and MFA, Printmaking all from the University of Iowa. Recent exhibitions include: *5th International Triennial of Graphic Art*, Prague, Czech Republic; *XIII Biennale Internationale de Gravure de Sarcennes*, Paris, France; and *International Contemporary Lithography*, Museum of Modern Art, Machynlleth, Wales.
