GENERAL INFORMATION

Registration Form and Entry Fee

The registration form and entry fee **MUST** be received by **Saturday, October 1, 2011.**

Works must be hand delivered on Friday, October 14, 2011, from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm to the Franklin Square Gallery, 130 E West Street, Southport, North Carolina. Directions and map available at web site: franklinsquaregallery.com

Eligibility

The show is open to artists 18 and older who are residents of Brunswick County or who are members of the Associated Artists of Southport, Oak Island Art Guild, Waterway Art Association, Coastal Carolina Camera Club or Brunswick Arts Council.

Conditions

Entries must be original works, not previously shown at the BAC Annual Fall Exhibition. Ceramics, drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, or a combination of the listed media created in the last four years (2007 - 2011) will be considered. 2D art works must be suitably framed and securely wired ready to hang. 2D Entries 30" or larger must be framed under plexiglas. All entries must not exceed 40" in any direction. Three dimensional work must not exceed 50 pounds. No entry that requires the artist to be present for moving or assembly will be accepted..

Entry Fee

A maximum of two art works are allowed per artist. Submit a non-refundable entry fee of \$30. Make check payable to: Brunswick Arts Council. (See entry form)

Sales

Artists will receive 100% of sales price. Works may be listed as *Not For Sale*.

Awards Reception

Artists in the exhibition, members of the Brunswick Arts Council, supporting guilds and organizations, and friends are invited to a reception on Sunday October 23, 2011, from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm (award ceremony at 3:00 pm).

The Awards Reception and the Art Exhibition are open to the public at no charge.

Each entry will be judged as a unique art work relating to the elements of art, success of craftsmanship, presentation, and theme.

JUDGES

3D-Judge: Catherine Coulter Lloyd is Visual Arts Specialist at Maria V. Howard Arts Center in Rocky Mount, NC. Originally born and raised in Asheville, NC, she has lived and worked all over the state. She has worked in arts administration for over 10 years in a variety of capacities including curator, education director, collections manager, registrar, gallery shop manager, preparator, and sales associate. Lloyd has served on the board of the North Carolina Museum Council as Government Affairs Chair. She obtained a BFA from Western Carolina University and an MFA from East Carolina University with a focus in ceramics.

2D Judge: Russell Yerkes is a signature member of the American Watercolor Society, National Watercolor Society, Southern Watercolor Society, Transparent Watercolor Society of America and the Watercolor Society of North Carolina where he is 2002 - 2004 and 2009 - 2010 Past President. Russell is a self taught watercolorist creating and selling artwork professionally for the past 15 years whereas he has received numerous awards including a High Winds Award Medal in an American Watercolor Society Exhibition and the Skyledge Award in the annual Transparent Watercolor Society of America Exhibition. Most recently Russell was invited to be one of 26 American watercolorist to be part of an international Exhibition of Contemporary Masters in Nanjing, China 2007 and 2010.
