



Individual Artist's Grant Program

The Brunswick Arts Council Individual Artist's Grant Program is intended to provide financial assistance to qualifying artists residing in Brunswick County.

Our mission is to inspire and promote appreciation and education for a broad range of arts and cultural interests in the Brunswick County community. This year funding has been set aside for distribution to artists who prepare a well-documented grant proposal to demonstrate that funding will significantly advance their artistic goals.

Applicants must be Brunswick County residents for one year or more who are 18 years of age and older. Previous grant recipients cannot apply in consecutive years.



Individual Artist's Grant Program Information

The following categories will be considered for this grant program:

- **2-D Work in All Media**

(Excluding fiber art, crafts, folk art, airbrush, computer generated/altered imagery, kits, or copies of published artwork or photography.)

- **3-D Work in Sculpture or Pottery**

- **Basket Weaving**

- **Wood Carving**

- **Novels, Short Stories, Poetry**

- **Theater**

- **Music**



Individual Artist's Grant Program Information

The Brunswick Arts Council Individual Artist's Grant Application *must* include the following information:

1. An explanation of how the funds will be used.

Listed below are some examples of how the funds can be used:

Training - Fees for attending a workshop or a special class given by an established teacher in the artist's field.

Travel - Specify the cost of transportation, lodging and food associated with special training.

Career Promotion - Creating a portfolio or a website.

Material Needs - Purchasing materials necessary for the advancement of your artistic goals.

2. Supporting materials.

Documentation of work which has been completed in the last three years and relates directly to the proposed project. Awards, honors, reviews, programs, catalogs may be included.

3. Digital Images on a CD are required for Visual Artists' applications which includes 2-D and 3-D works. Submit a minimum of 5 Digital Images that are identified with applicant's name, title of the work and medium. CD label must have artist name, titles of work and medium. Screen resolution must be 72 dpi.

4. Manuscripts up to twelve pages in double spaced typed format must be submitted for Literary Artist applications which includes poetry, playwriting, novels or short stories.

Review all items carefully to complete your application.
